3. **Application must be complete and submitted to secretary@apgwoa.org no later than the submission deadline.**
4. **Scholarship awards of up to \$500 are available to active members or dependents who are a full-time or part-time student in an educational institution and who are related to an active member of the APG-EA "Silver" Chapter of the USAWOA.**
5. **The scholarship grant may be used for tuition, fees and/or books during one academic year.**
6. **The scholarship may be awarded to a previous winner of award in subsequent years; however, the individual must compete for the scholarship on the same basis as a first-time applicant.**



Aberdeen-Edgewood "Silver" Chapter USAWOA Scholarship Instructions

1. Submit an essay describing "My educational goals and how they will benefit the world around us." (800 – 1000 words) Include word count and signature at bottom. If you applied before, this must be a new essay.
2. Submit a resume outlining your academic background to include activities in which you have participated, office to which you have been elected or appointed, and honors which have been awarded (scholastic, citizenship, athletic, etc.).
3. Provide two letters of recommendation, written within the last 12 months, must be enclosed with the resume. Military Members can use Leaders and Commanders. Students should use their high school (or foreign equivalent) counselor, teacher, coach or faculty advisor if already attending college or trade school.
4. Submit High school, college or trade school transcript showing grades and grade point average.
